

Study Abroad Report/Journal Requirements

All Business students participating in a study abroad term (semester or summer session), must submit a report along with a journal or blog in order to have this experience satisfy one summer term (part-time) of co-op experience. There should be at least one journal/blog entry for every week that you are studying abroad.

The report should address the following questions and be a reflection of your learning:

1. What did you learn about the culture of the country in which you studied?
2. What did you learn that you could share with your peers to improve their understanding of the country and international business?
3. Have your experiences changed your perception of the country prior to this trip? Explain.
4. What if anything surprised you?
5. From this experience, what could be applied to your major? Explain.
6. Include any work experience you had while participating on the study abroad program.
7. Include the dates of the program.
8. Report should be 5 to 8 pages.

Students must complete one semester or two summers (part-time) of co-op. Students may only waive one “summer” (part-time) of co-op with a study abroad experience. Students will still be responsible for completing a second “summer” (part-time) of co-op.
